Prevention

(1) OKANA + Local authorities



71 Prevention Centers

(2) Scientific support + financial support + coordination

Personnel: 6 prevention workers (1 psychiatrist, 3 psychologists, 2 social workers) + secretary

Prefecture of Evros

Greece

Epidemiology

- 12% of students aged 13-18 reported lifetime use of any illicit drug
- · cannabis is the illicit substance most widely used by the student population

(ESPAD survey 2007)

· Counseling services addressed to adolescents showing experimental use of cannabis

<u>Target group</u>: Adolescents aged 15 - 18 years old with experimental cannabis use

Size of sample: 47 adolescents

Aims:



1. Termination of drug use

2. Reference to a therapeutic program

Sources of reference:

family (70,21%)

school (10,63%)

friends (10,63%)

police (8,51%)



Prevention Center of Evros (1998-...)

*Family
Systematic and coordinated action
through groups of parents, seminars etc

*Police

Systematic action through meetings of awareness and sensitization

Prevention Center of Evros (1998-...)

The creation of a stable and important network of sensitized and well informed people on:

prevention issues

services offered by the PC

Because of:

- (a) the particularities of the target group (adolescents) but also
- (b) the fact that it is estimated that the attendance of the family in the intervention increases the probabilities of success

Type of intervention:

Adolescents

Parents

Adolescents:

individualised intensive or, short term counselling interventions

Adolescents:

Aim: to give them the opportunity to find meaning in their life away from substance dependency

Parents:

Parallel counselling support of parents and in some cases counselling meetings with the participation of all the family members

Parents:

Aim: to empower and support the family, in order that its members communicate among them more effectively and establish functional relations so as to deter the young person's involvement in drug use

Methodology

- 1. Motivational techniques:
- Motivational interviewing
- Empathy
- Non critical approach etc
- 2. Techniques based on:
- Family therapy
- · Individual systemic counselling
- 3. Psychodynamic theory

Follow up

Follow up sessions after 6 months in 82,97% of the cases

Sessions — - Adolescents or - Parents

Results:

- 57,4% of adolescents: stopped the drug use
- 27,02% of adolescents, after suitable preparation, were referred to a therapeutic program
- 27,02% of adolescents: interrupted the collaboration
