1000 Years of Art – From the Middle Ages to the Present Day

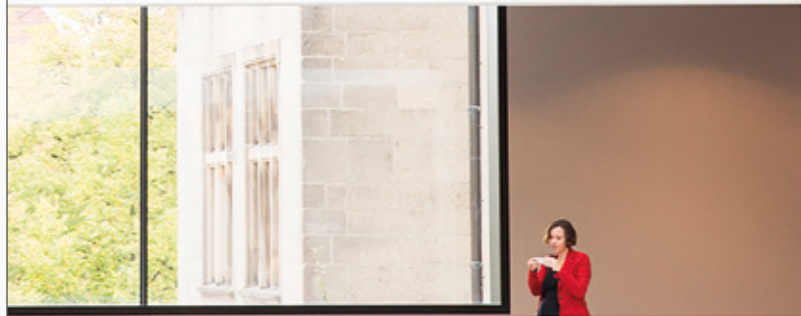
Welcome in the LWL-Museum für Kunst und Kultur! I would like to invite you to explore our new art museum and discover the treasures on display in the collection's 51 exhibition spaces.

From the spacious foyer your route to the works of art begins at the open stairway to the first level. Here you have a choice: if you would like to go from era to era, encountering all the exhibition spaces and missing none of them, then I recommend following the signed route through the museum. This begins in room 1.01 and leads you from the Middle Ages, through the Renaissance, to the Baroque, into the 19th century, and concludes with modern and contemporary art.

If you are interested in a particular work or era, you are also free to directly enter several of the spaces. All the exhibition spaces are also accessible by lift from the foyer. Members of staff at the information desk are always available either to answer your questions, or to receive suggestions and feedback.

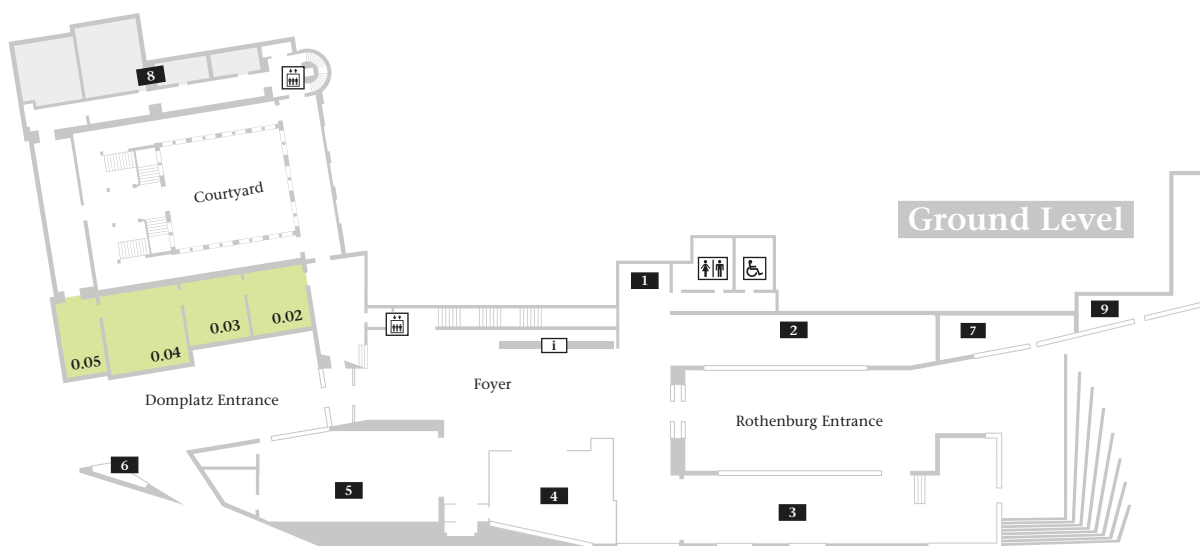
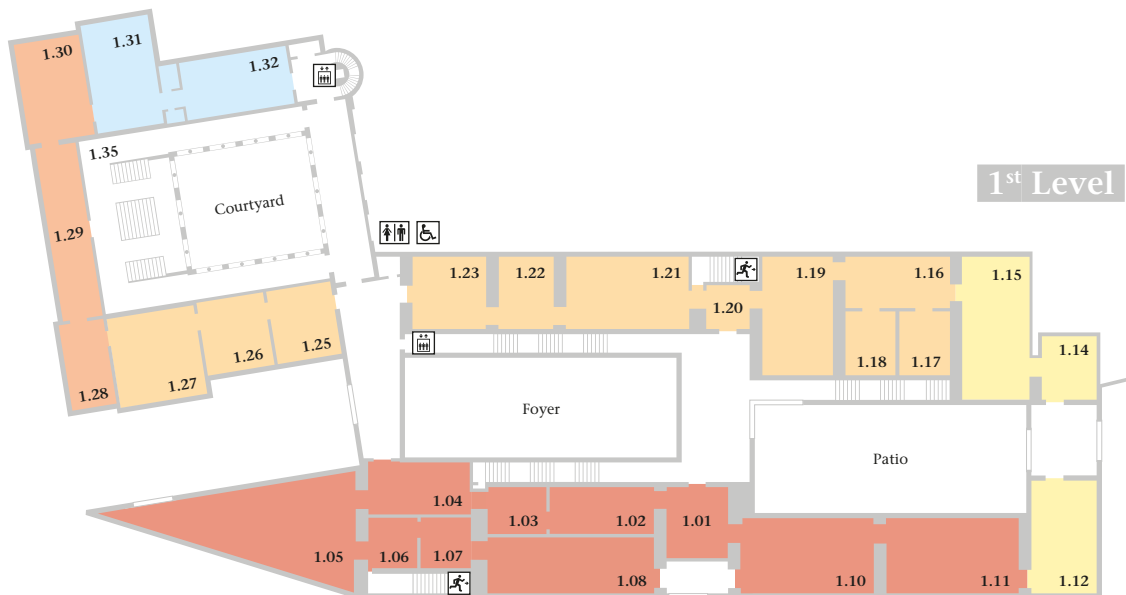
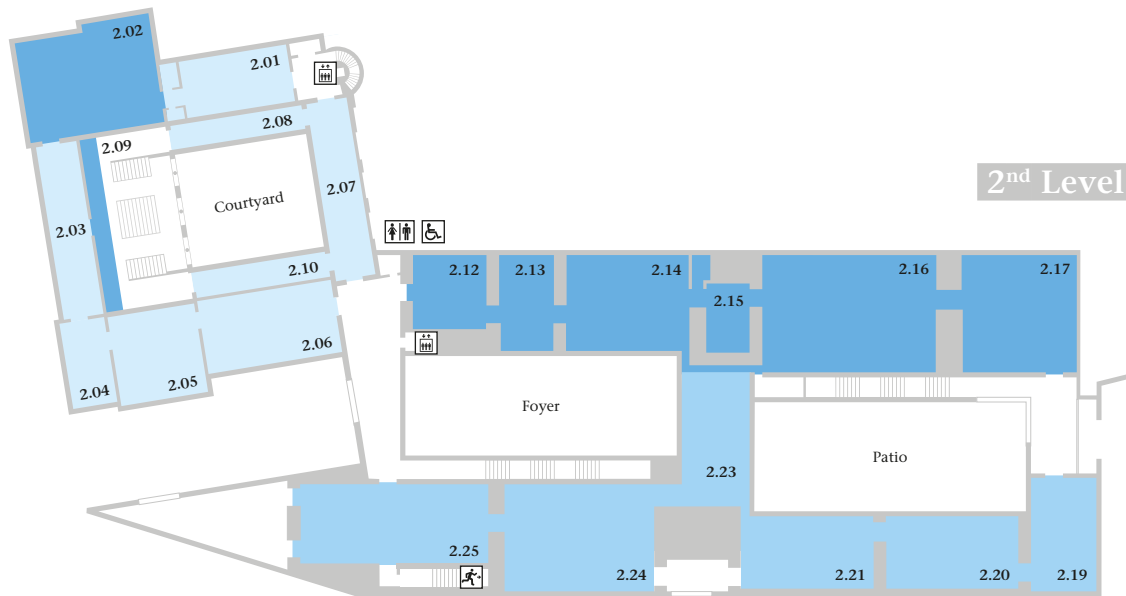
