One Ticket for Three Exhibitions

Combined Ticket for “IMPERIUM KONFLIKT MYTHOS.
2000 Years Varus Battle” Now Available.

Detmold/ Haltern am See/ Kalkriese, 5th December 2008

A combined ticket is now available for the exhibition project “IMPERIUM KONFLIKT MYTHOS. 2000 Years Varus Battle” six months before the opening. Adults can visit the exhibitions in Westphalian Haltern am See, in Detmold (Kreis Lippe) and in Lower Saxony’s Kalkriese for 18 Euros. The ticket is valid from 16th May throughout the whole exhibition period (until 25th October 2009).

“The ticket is a super idea for a present for everyone who still has room in Christmas stockings or under the Christmas tree”, says Dr. Rudolf Asskamp, Head of the LWL-Römermuseum in Haltern am See. Using the combined tickets, visitors have a saving of nine Euros, that is the cost of admission to one of the three museums. The same applies to reduced priced tickets (12 Euros) and family tickets (40 Euros). The combined tickets are now available in the three museums involved in the project (LWL-Römermuseum in Haltern am See, Lippisches Landesmuseum Detmold, Museum und Park Kalkriese) and soon the tourist information offices in the three regions.

The LWL-Römermuseum will deal with the Roman Empire at the height of its power in the exhibition “IMPERIUM KONFLIKT MYTHOS. 2000 Years Varus Battle” (16th May until 11th October 2009). The focus will be on art, culture and propaganda at the time of Emperor Augustus. Beginning with the Varus Battle, the exhibition “CONFLICT” (15th of May until 25th October 2009) in the Museum und Park Kalkriese, will trace the way taken by the Germanic tribes to a position of power in ancient Europe. With the help of archaeological treasures it shows, amongst other things, who the Germanic tribes were, how they were able to defeat the Romans and why war was their recipe for success. The scope of the exhibition “MYTH” in the Lippisches Landesmuseum Detmold (16th May until 25th October 2009) will be from Roman historiography to modern research.

It shows what effects the myth around the battle had on German and European history and, apart from this, provides numerous insights into the everyday life and social structures of the Germanic tribes.
