

Skulptur Projekte at the LWL-Museum für Kunst und Kultur

Six artists have selected the LWL-Museum für Kunst und Kultur as the location for their contributions to Skulptur Projekte 2017, five approaches which consider the museum spaces in very differing ways, resulting in new modes of experiencing them.

Nora Schultz, Michael Dean, John Knight, Cosima von Bonin / Tom Burr and Gregor Schneider are sitting the discussion on art in public spaces in our museum, a place that many people already regard as a public one, whether during their lunch break on the sunny square in front of the museum, as a shortcut to Domplatz or as a meeting place on "long Fridays" when admission is free.

The Skulptur Projekte Archiv, a part of the collection of contemporary art comprising countless archival items from the previous four exhibitions, is firmly anchored in the institution. The presentation "Double Check. Michael Asher's Installation Münster (Caravan) '77 '87 '97 '07" is dedicated to the strategies of an artist who participated in the previous four iterations of Skulptur Projekte. (Gallery 1.35)

On the second Friday of the month the museum's entry is free of charge.

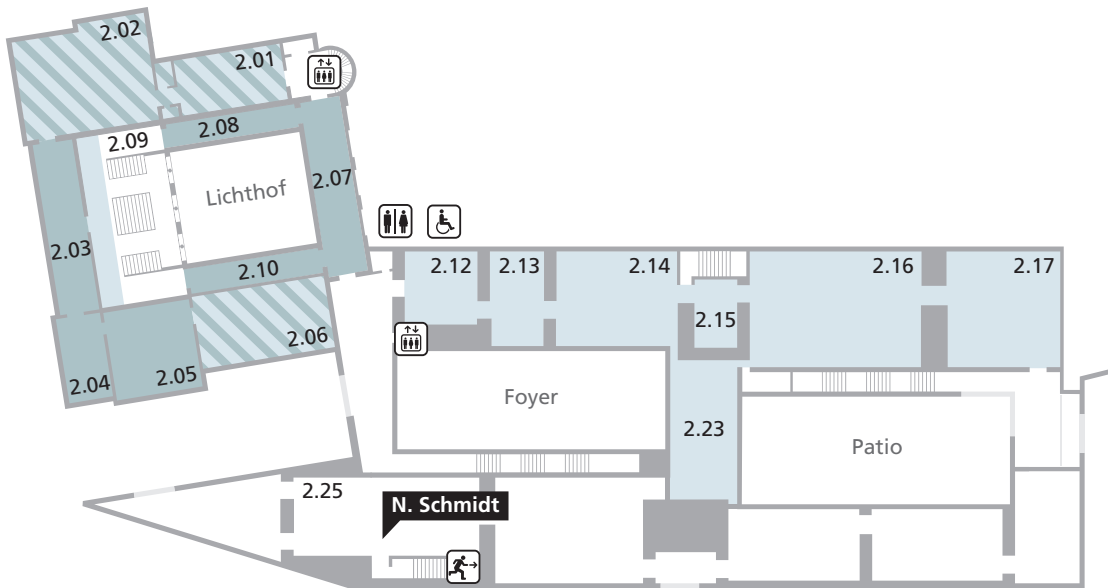

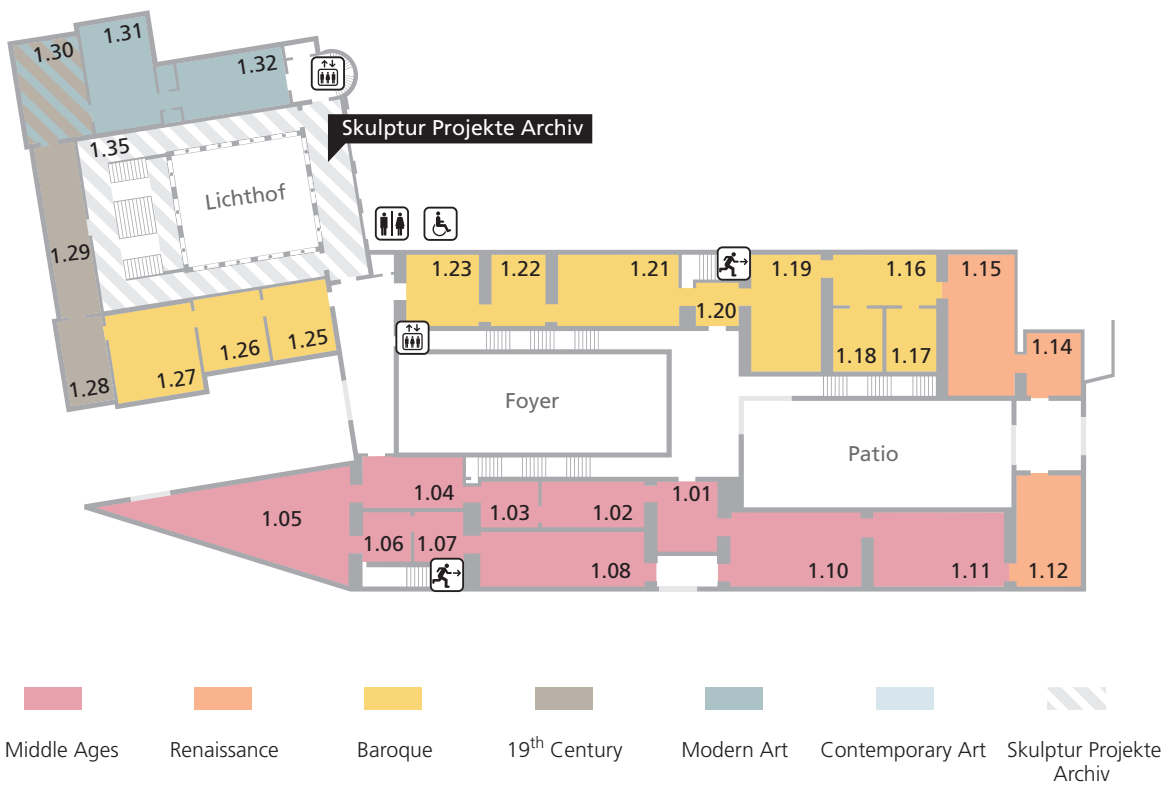

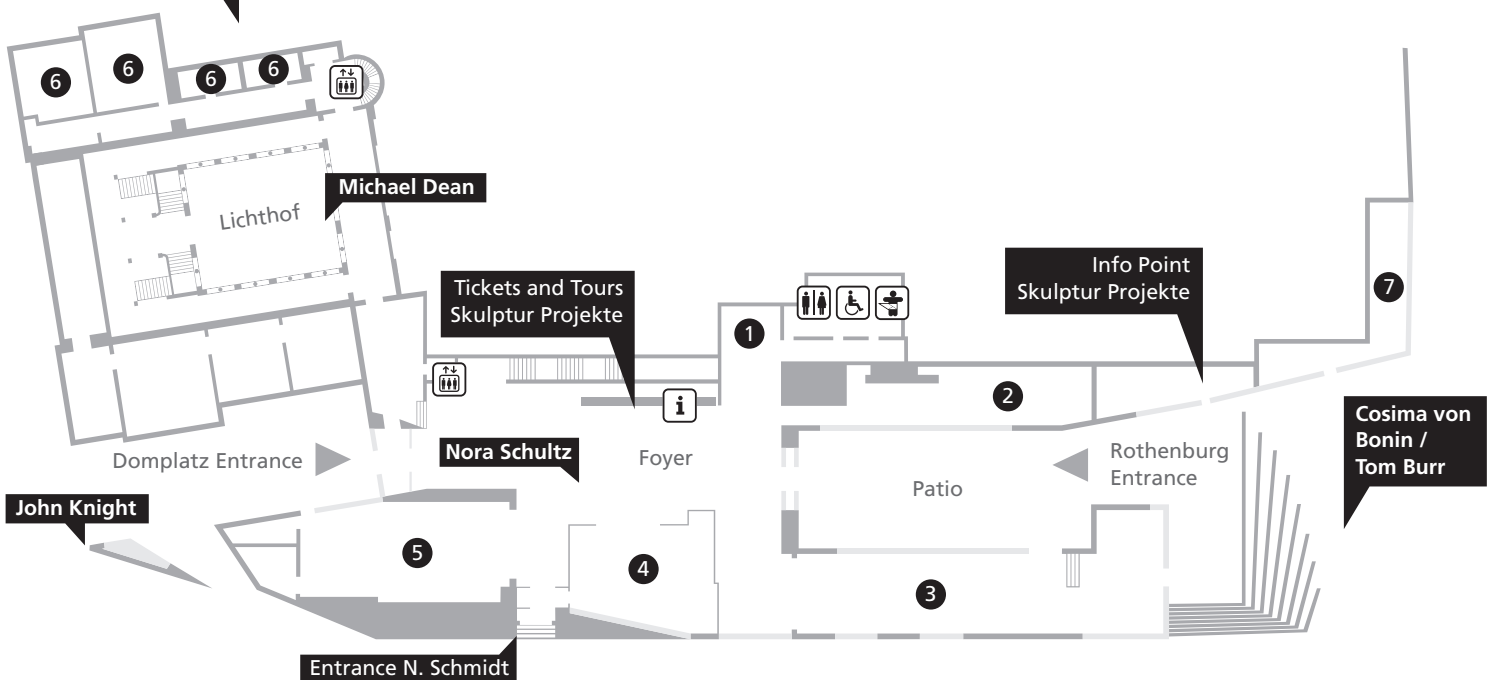


Gallery 1.05 *Mary and ten Apostles from the west portal of the so-called Überwasser church in Münster*, around 1370 / 74
